Summary of the Portugal National Multiplier Event

The Portugal National Multiplier Event for the ASSIST project took place across two separate sessions held on the 6th of November and the 24th of November, 2025. Both events took place at the Library of Agrupamento de Escolas Poeta Joaquim Serra (AEPJS) in Montijo, Portugal. The multiplier events were organized by AidLearn, Consultoria em Recursos Humanos, Lda., and hosted in collaboration with Centro de Formação de Montijo e Alcochete (CENFORMA), and Centro Qualifica Poeta Joaquim Serra do AEPJS (CQ-PJS).

In total, 44 participants attended the multiplier event; 21 individuals on the 6th of November, and 23 participants on the 24th of November. The participants represented a strong engagement with the project and its objectives.

The programme opened with welcome remarks from representatives of both AidLearn (Maria Helena Antunes) and CQ-PJS (Zita Domingues), followed by a brief introduction to AidLearn, the ASSIST project (consortium, objectives, outputs), and the scope of the ASSIST research study presented by Claudia Viana. The central presentation focused on social engineering, addressing various forms of attacks and corresponding preventive measures, accompanied by real case studies that encouraged reflection and discussion among attendees (presented by Zita Domingues & Marisol Carmelino). Participants engaged in guided discussions and case analysis, facilitated by the speakers' insights and practical knowledge-sharing (guided by Ana Basto, João Alves, Nuno Lavrado, e José Ferreira). The sessions concluded with a summary of key points, final remarks, and closing reflections (see Annex 1). Overall, both events successfully disseminated the project outcomes, fostered knowledge exchange on cybersecurity awareness, and encouraged active participation from the educational community.
